## PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

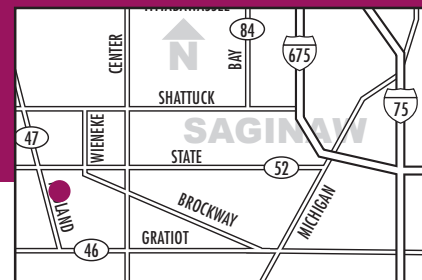
